

TOWN OF TWO HILLS

BYLAW NO. 2005 - 831

BEING BYLAW No. 2005 - 831 in the Town of Two Hills in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of declaring specific portions of roads as school zones and authorizing the erection of school zone signs to designate the area so declared.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Two Hills deem it advisable that specific portions of roadways referred to in this bylaw be declared as school zones for the protection of children who utilize the facilities,

NOW THEREFORE, the council of the Town of Two Hills, in the Province of Alberta, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. School zones in the Town of Two Hills will be:
 - a) Along 49th Street, from 53rd Avenue to 47th Avenue,
 - b) Along 53rd Avenue, from 49th Street to 48th Street,
 - c) Along 48th Street, from 53rd Avenue to 50th Avenue,
 - d) Along 51st Avenue, from 49th Street to 48th Street, and
 - e) Along 50th Avenue, from 49th Street to 48th Street.
2. On any day no driver shall drive within the school zone at a rate of speed greater than 30 kilometers per hour at any time between the hours of:

8:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m.
11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
3:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

On school days.
3. School zone signs stating that 30 kilometers per hour is the maximum speed on roads in school zones shall be erected to designate those portions of the roadways within the Town of Two Hills for the guidance of any person or driver of any vehicle traveling on these roadways.
4. Any person found guilty of violating the speed as indicated by the erected school zone signs is subject to the penalties described in the Traffic Safety Act, RSA 2000, Chapter T-6 and amendments thereto.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day of the final reading thereof.
