## BY-LAW NO. 95-727 OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS

A By-law of the Town of Two Hills, in the Province of Alberta to reduce the number of Council members required on the Two Hills Town Council.

WHEREAS there are presently seven (7) council members, including the Mayor on the Municipal council of the Town of Two Hills;

AND WHEREAS Section 143(2) of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter 26-1 R.S.A. 1994, states that "The council of a city or town consists of seven (7) Councillors unless Council passes a by-law specifying a higher or lower odd number";

AND WHEREAS Council deems it appropriate that the Two Hills Town Council should consist of five (5) Councillors, including the Mayor;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this by-law has been advertised in accordance with Sections 144 and 606 of the new Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta 1994;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Two Hills Council, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

THAT the Two Hills Town Council shall consist of five (5) members of Council, four (4) members to be known as councillors and one (1) member (Chief Elected Official) who shall be known as the Mayor.

THIS BY-LAW shall come into effect at the general election to be held on October 16, 1995, and shall be deemed to be passed on third and final reading.

READ a first time this 27th day of March, 1995 A.D.

READ a second time this 10th day of April, 1995 A.D.

READ a third time this 10th day of April, 1995 A.D.
