A few words from the Mayor

The end of August and September have been quite busy in our community. At the end of August, Robert Moretti resigned as CAO for the town. His resignation was accepted and we began the search for a new CAO. There were a lot of applicants, some the same as from the previous search.

In the end we went with a local lad. You as a community have put your faith in him four consecutive times re-electing him to town council. Mr. Gerren Saskiw has accepted the position and will be starting on October first. As we move forward, Council feels that Gerren will fit right in. He knows the issues and the financial restraints that the town works under. He has grown up here and lives in the community. Like so many other CAO's that the town has had over the years, Gerren will learn. He will carry out his duties to help the town in these challenging times. A by-election will be held November 27. Nomination day will be October 16.

A major water disruption occurred on a Friday around the supper hour. It was all hands-on deck. The problem area was isolated but not before a significant amount of water was lost. The amount of water lost was a concern but the large amount of air in the lines was a greater concern. I am happy to report that there were no major water line breaks because of the air in the lines. A review of procedures will be looked at by administration. If improvements are needed, they will be implemented.

How this will affect the town, I am not sure but funding cuts are coming. How severe these funding cuts will be will be answered on October 24, with the release of the provincial budget. Remember this budget is a provincial budget that will affect us all.
