



1. **ABCRC Community Champions Program Grant:** applied for by Ava and we have been approved. The Alberta Beverage Container Recycling Corporation grant is to cover the cost of recycling containers for bottles and garbage. We will be receiving 13 containers to be placed at various locations around town. As a grant condition, we have to regularly report container counts as it is how the effectiveness of the CCP is measured to ensure future funding to help keep Alberta Clean & Green.
2. **\$25,000 County Recreation Funding Grant - Dispersal by Town of Two Hills:** the cheque returned to the County has been returned to the Town for our dispersal on behalf of the County. The decision for funds dispersal will be made at this meeting.
3. **Town of Two Hills Staff:** to clear up some misinformation and misinterpretation from comments made during previous meetings. I am very happy with all staff at the Town of Two Hills; everyone is doing a great job, are qualified for their positions and we are working very well as a team. We continue to improve, learn, look out for each other and move forward. I would not replace any one member on my team. Lastly, we do not need to hire an accountant for any position.
4. **Slip & Fall Lawsuit - Centennial Hall Parking Lot:** this incident from November 22, 2018 during the Mammogram Screening Clinic is still active.
5. **AHS's Mammogram Screen Test Mobile Clinic:** is returning to Two Hills May 3-5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Centennial Hall parking lot in Geleta Park.
6. **Town of Two Hills Regional Meeting Request concerning Health Care:** the Mayor's request to meet with the Mayors, Reeves and Chiefs from other municipalities in the north east region is getting positive responses. To date we have received replies from 13 of the 38 sent. We need to pick a few dates for the meeting to let others know.
7. **Town of Two Hills Council Meeting Streaming (analytics):** 5 to 8 people are watching and up to 11 viewing a council meeting. The public can now choose to attend our meetings in person [again] or [still] view streaming of our meetings on our website.
8. **Alberta Provincial Police Service study report:** Justice & Solicitor General staff are touring the Province to discuss the report, however JSG staff have made it clear that they will not be taking any "politicized" feedback to the Minister or answering any questions seen as "out of scope" of the report. The Minister needs to hear all comments on the report and the future state of policing. The AUMA will be our advocacy group going forward and ensure that municipality's voices are heard.
9. **MSP (Municipal Stimulus Program) Funding:** we have heard back from the Minister of Municipal Affairs that the Town of Two Hills has until the end of 2022 to use the \$171,528 to pave 45 Ave from Hwy 36 - 54 St (Arena Road).
