

BYLAW NO. 97-758

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF PROVINCIAL E-911 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 54 of the Municipal Government Act, a municipality may provide any service or thing that is provided in all or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority.

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Two Hills Council wishes to provide Provincial E-911 service within the municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such service.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Two Hills duly assembled and acts as follows:


1. The Town of Two Hills will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E-911 service.
2. The Town of Two Hills will enter into an agreement with the Strathcona County to provide the E-911 Call Answer Services.
3. The Town of Two Hills will enter into an agreement with Telus Communications Inc. in order that Telus will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
4. A customer within the Town of Two Hills who subscribes to Telus' Exchange Service will be provided with the E-911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.
5. This Bylaw shall take effect on the day of its final passing thereof.
