2. I understand that the granting of an Urban Hen Coop License shall not exempt myself, the applicant, from complying with the other Town of Two Hills Bylaws, or other Provincial and Federal Regulations.
3. I acknowledge that I am required to obtain a Premises Identification Number (PID) through Alberta Agriculture and Rural Development.
4. I certify that I will conform to all Urban Hen Coop Regulations upon receiving the Urban Hen Coop License and that failure to do so may result in termination of the Urban Hen Coop License.

9.13 Urban Hen Coop






GENERAL RULES

-  Applicant must be the property owner or if a tenant have an authorization letter from property owner
-  Not exceed one (1) urban coop per property
-  Roosters are not permitted
-  House a maximum of three (3) urban hens
-  Urban hens are to be contained within the coop at all times
-  Not involve the slaughter of hens on the property

COOP RULES

-  Coops must be located in the rear yard and no less than 1 metre from any side or rear property line if less than 4 metres in height or no less than 1.5 meters from any side or rear property line if greater than 4 meters in height and to not exceed 4.5 metres in height
-  Coops must provide 4' of interior floor area and 9.7' of securely enclosed outdoor area per urban hen
-  Provide one perch, of at least 15cm in length and one nest box per urban hen
-  Be maintained in good repair and sanitary condition, and free from vermin and noxious or offensive smells and substances
-  Constructed to and maintained to prevent any rodent from harbouring underneath or within walls, and to prevent entrance by any other animal

CARE & FEEDING RULES

-  Sufficient living conditions for each hen with access to food, water, shelter, light, air ventilation, care and opportunities for dust-bathing, scratching and roosting
-  Have leftover feed, trash and manure removed in a timely and safe manner
-  Have feed stored within a fully enclosed container
-  Have manure stored within a fully enclosed 3 cubic foot container
-  Follow biosecurity procedures recommended by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency to reduce potential for disease outbreaks
