

- 1. Arena ICE Plant. The plant will NOT be started again this season, even though Covid restrictions on recreation have been eased. Since the plant is usually shut down mid to late March, it is not worth turning the plant back on because of the cost. The ice should last for a few weeks to be used.
- **2. CARES Grant**. The government has been notified that the Town of Two Hills is going to be returning the matching money of \$49,000. Council has decided that we do not need to do any further Broadband studies and we do not have any extra money to match.
- **3. RFP for Concrete Crushing**. Will be sent out soon.
- **4. Capital Projects**. We will have a list of possible projects for this summer for council in March and then council will decide which projects to move forward with.
- **5. Broadband in Two Hills.** What to do moving forward? Do we put out a questionnaire or survey? We need more feedback from residents.
- 6. Municipal Operating Support Transfer (MOST) Allocations. MOST funding of \$151,000 for the Town of Two Hills must be spent on eligible expenses incurred between April 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021. (This does not apply to funding allocated under the operating component of the Municipal Sustainability Initiative (MSI), which continues to be governed by the MSI Operating Program Guidelines.)
