LETTER FROM THE MAYOR

Annually, the town experiences the tendency for some residents in town to shovel snow onto the town streets, when this is just done before the grader goes by, it is usually okay. BUT we recently had an instance where homeowner pushed quite a bit of snow on the street, it got cold and the pile froze and was covered with a dusting of snow, a vehicle hit the snowbank, and it caused thousands of dollars in damage and the property owner could be liable. It is in everyone's best interest that we respect our neighbors and fellow citizens upon this cold and snowy time by keeping our sidewalks and streets clear. In the last newsletter, the town posted its bylaw for snow removal. The bylaw has provisions for fines to be issued. If there should be an accident or mishap, the person may be held liable for damages.

With the cost of so many things going up, the town has received an increase for garbage pickup. Though this is the first increase in five years, it is quite substantial. Administration is looking at what the increase will mean to the average resident or business for it will have to be passed on.

The Town of Two Hills has some prime real estate and that is in the golf course area. A part of this subdivision was never completed with water and sewer. That is about to change. With an increase from the province for capital projects, we will be finishing this subdivision. Engineering plans have been found allowing us to proceed. Tree removal will begin shortly. With the opening of these prime lots, the town hopes to increase the tax base with new homes.

Just a quick mention that the town has formalized the agreement for the new town shop with Green Hills Construction. Construction should begin as soon as the weather allows.

REMINDER: REMOVAL OF SNOW AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS

All persons owning, occupying or controlling premises in all areas of the Town shall remove and clear away all snow, ice, dirt, and other obstructions from the sidewalk in any highway adjoining such premises within 48 hours of the time that such snow, ice, dirt, or other obstruction was deposited thereon. No person shall place, or cause to be placed or displaced, upon any roadway any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction.
