I am pleased to announce that Two Hills has received a \$985,000 grant from the Alberta Government to update the ice plant at the arena, EV charger and solar panels to alleviate some operational costs. There will still be some fund raising to complete the project. Together with the Ag Society, we were presented with the good news from our MLA Jackie Armstrong-Homeniuk who went above and beyond for our town. On behalf of Two Hills, Thank you Jackie!

REMINDER: REMOVAL OF SNOW AND OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS

All persons owning, occupying or controlling premises in all areas of the Town shall remove and clear away all snow, ice, dirt, and other obstructions from the sidewalk in any highway adjoining such premises within 48 hours of the time that such snow, ice, dirt, or other obstruction was deposited thereon. No person shall place, or cause to be placed or displaced, upon any roadway any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction.
