Letter from the Mayor

The golf course subdivision was started by the town in the 1970's and council at the time, made the decision not to put water and sewer to all the lots in the area which resulted in this area being one of the slowest areas to see housing development. As reported in the February 2025 newsletter that, with the aid of provincial grants, the town is moving ahead with several, much needed infrastructure projects and this area is one of them. With the town maintaining a position of not having to borrow the funds to complete the installation of water and sewer to the undeveloped lots, council felt it prudent to finally finish this 50+ year-old endeavor and make these lots saleable. The lucrative location will be alluring to prospective retirees wanting to have the amenities of small-town life with an award-winning golf course merely steps away.

Council has finalized the budget and the mill rate for 2025 and is pleased with the balanced budget and the ability to lower the residential tax rate. Some residents may see a slight increase while others may see a decrease in taxes due to assessments increasing overall in the town. Council tries its best to be fiscally responsible.
