Remember this is a municipal election year. Packages are available at the town office for interested individuals. The Mayor and 4 councillor positions are up for election.

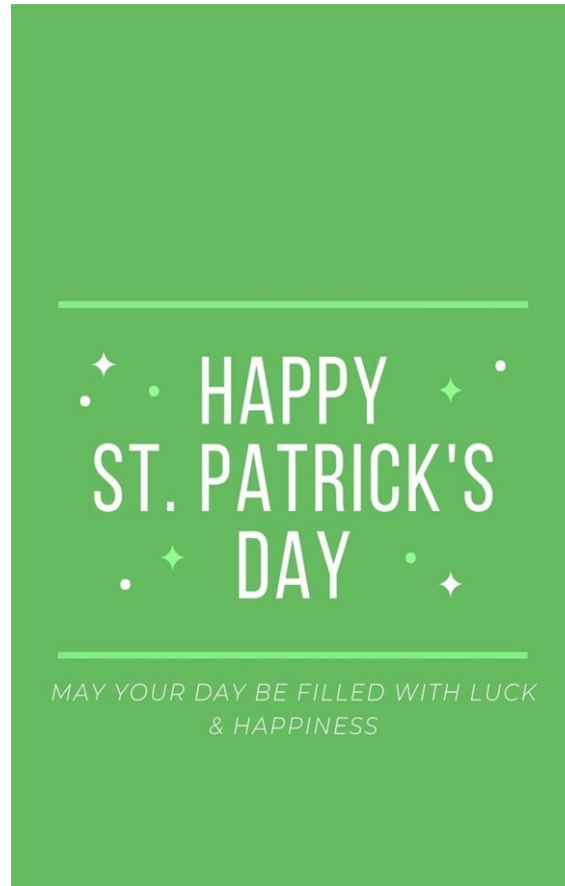
Till next month, please continue to abide by the provincial health guidelines & take care.

Cracks and holes can result in freezing water. Seal them up properly.

Using heating tape can keep the pipes from freezing.

Keep the heat in the home on. This means pipes also stay warm.

Allowing drips from actual faucets can help relieve pressure.
