Amalgamation is still a priority for this council. In July a representative from Municipal affairs will be coming out to meet with us. They, hopefully will lay out the framework on how to proceed.

The software problem for our new water meters has been fixed according to the manufacturer. Some will be installed on a test basis. Once they are found to be operational everyone will be switched over to the new system.

Our 2022 balanced budget was difficult to create. The province advised us to increase our power, natural gas and fuel prices by 30% over 2021. The budget that we passed reflects a decrease in staff and a reduction in other expenses while maintaining a level of service residents expect. Going forward, administration will assist any resident with a plan to pay their 2022 taxes. The 2022 budget is on our website or can be picked up at the town office.
