BYLAW NO. 96-744 OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAW NO. 621 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO ESTABLISHING A PARKS BOARD TO IMPLEMENT AND PURSUE A RECREATION PROGRAM FOR THE TOWN OF TWO HILLS LAC SANTE TOURIST FACILITY.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the revised Statutes of Alberta, 1994, and amendments thereto, Council has the authority to amend or repeal a Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Two Hills, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled this 25th day of March, 1996 enacts as follows:

- 1) That the management of the Lac Sante Tourist Facility owned by the Town of two Hills will be provided by the administration of the Town of Two Hills under the direction and authority of the Council of the Town of Two Hills;
- 2) and that Bylaw No. 621 of the Town of Two Hills and amendments to are hereby repealed.
- This Bylaw comes into force and effect upon final passing.
